This article provides a summary for adding Schedules for Email Usage and SPLA report in MachPanel.

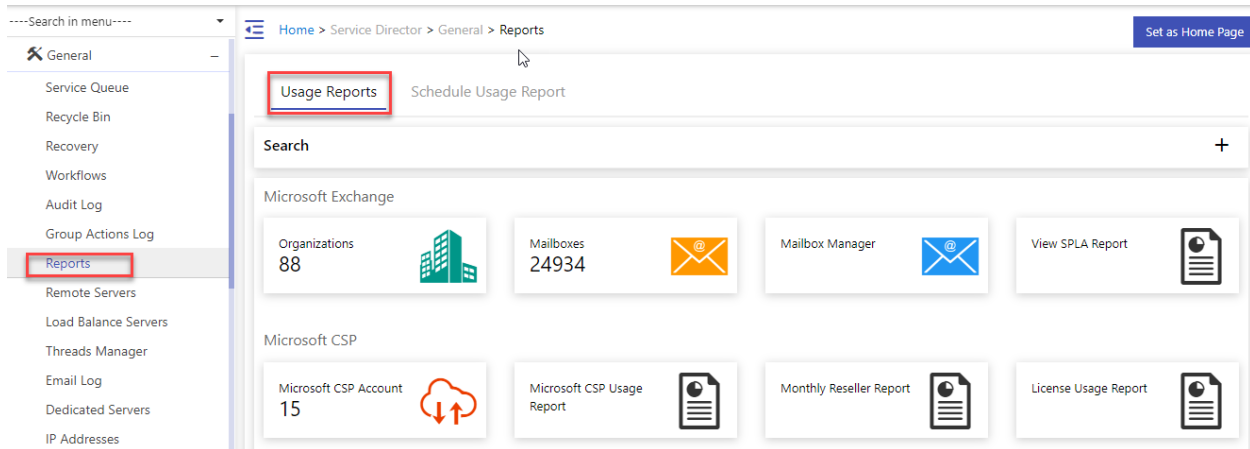

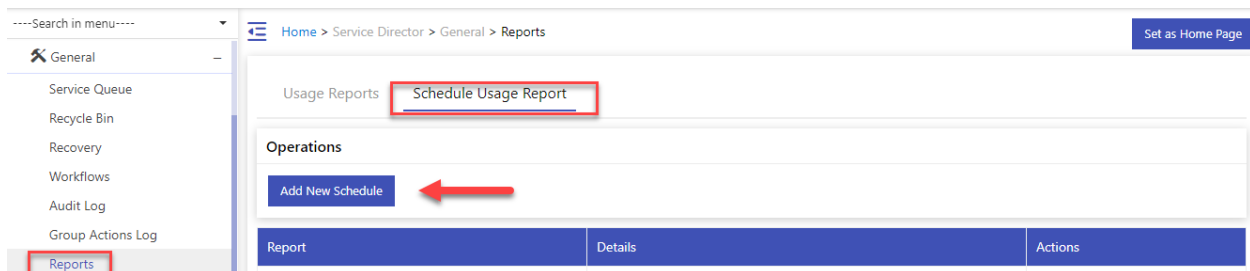
Email Scheduling of SPLA & Usage Reports:

In MachPanel Control Panel, email scheduling of Usage and SPLA reports is also supported. Please follow the steps as below in order to send scheduled Emails of Usage & SPLA report:

- To view SPLA & Usage reports, Navigate to the path: **Home >> Service Director >> General >> Reports**.



- To schedule emails for Usage reports and SPLA reports, Select **Schedule Usage Reports** tab.
- Click on **Add New Schedule** button. See the snapshot below:

Schedule Emails for Usage and SPLA reports

Under **Usage Report Schedule Settings** section, select report(s) to schedule.

- **Send To (Email Address):** Provide Send To email address.
- **From Address:** Provide From Address.
- **Email Text:** Provide text.
- **Send Frequency:** Select frequency for emails from the drop down list.
- **Time to Send:** Provide time in hours & minutes.

Once done click on **Save** button
