This article provides a summary for how to delete subscriptions and customers from MachPanel control Panel.

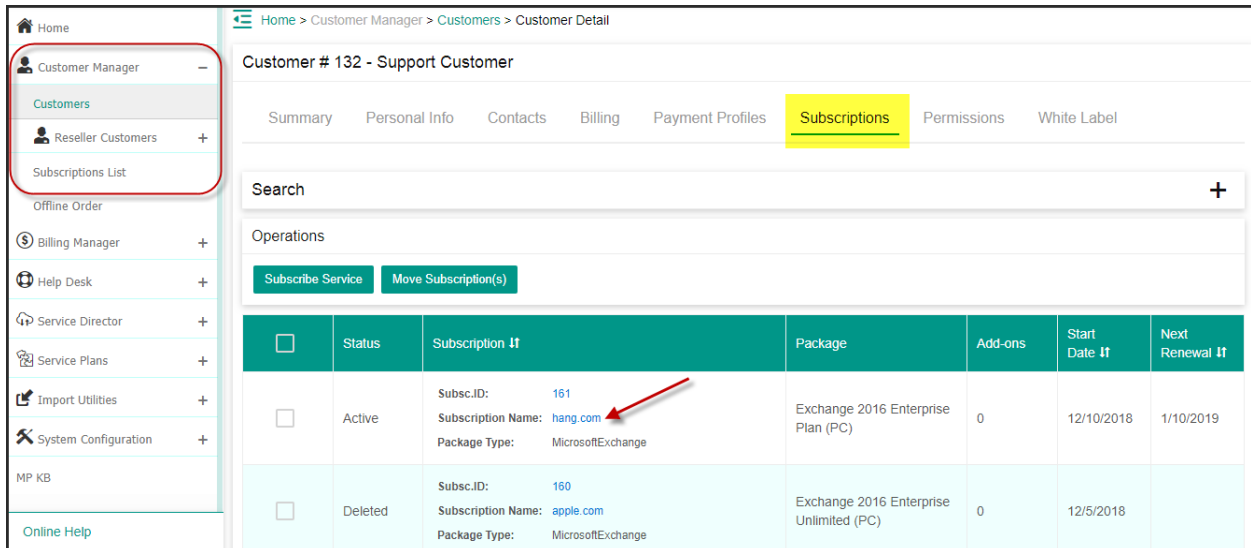

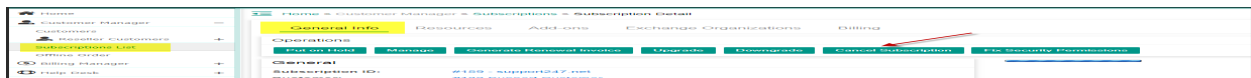
Solution

How to delete the subscription?

- To delete\remove the subscription from the MachPanel Control Panel, Go to customer section and click on **Customer Name**. You will see all the subscriptions of that customer as shown below:



- Select the subscription from the subscriptions list or navigate to the customer detail page and click on the **Subscription name** which is to be removed under **Subscriptions** tab as shown above:
- Now click on **Cancel Subscription** under **General Info** tab. See the snapshot below:

How to delete the customers?

In order to delete customers from MachPanel, navigate to the path: **Customer Manager >> Customers** or **Reseller Customers** and click on **Delete** link from options column. The following screen will appear.
