

Solution

The problem is being caused due to permissions / rights restrictions. Please create a new Folder on the SQL Server that hosts your MachPanel database for example "C:\MPDB-Backup" where you would like to create MachPanel database backup and assign "Write" permissions to "Users" group on this folder. After that provide this folder's path in MachPanel Configuration studio as shown in snapshot below:
