Summary

This article describes in detail about the Steps for **Domain Verification**.

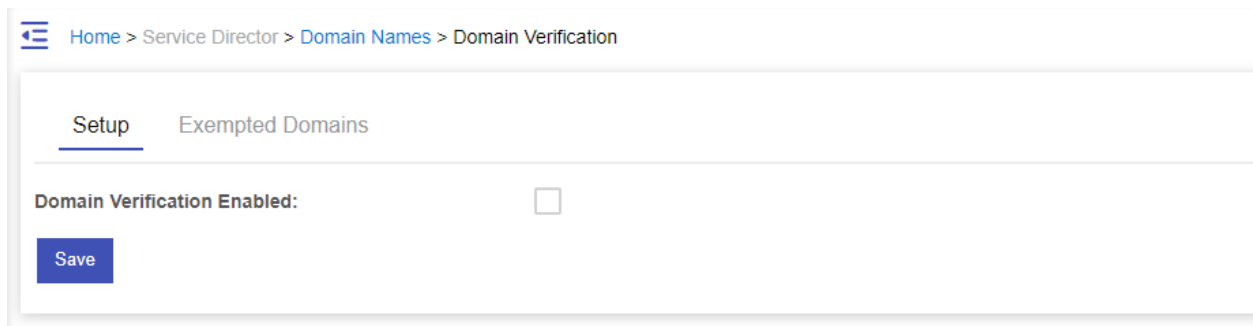
- Auto-remove unverified domain option is available now.
i.e. it will remove the non-verified domains automatically when the time reaches as mentioned say 7 days etc.
- Existing domains can also be skipped from verification by using the provided option.
- If disabled, Domain Verification would not be considered in panel.

Applies To

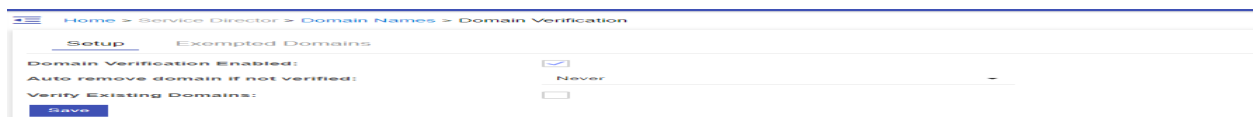
This article applies to MachPanel v6 and above.

STEPS:

- Navigate **Home > Service Director > Domain Names > Domain Verification**




- You can **Enable Domain Verification** (As shown in screenshot below).




Domain Verification




