

## Company Disclaimers:

You can also add company disclaimers to your exchange accounts by clicking on **Manage** from the following path: **Home >> Service Director >> Exchange Hosting >> Exchange Accounts >> Exchange Accounts.**

Select **Rules** tab.

Click **Add Disclaimer**. See the snapshot below:


